

How do I obtain a Dog or Cat License?

Licenses are available at the Treasurer's Office, City Hall, 900 Quay St., Manitowoc, WI. According to Municipal Code 14.01(2) Tax and Late Fees: The license tax shall be \$10.00 for a neutered male dog or cat or spayed female dog or cat and \$15.00 for an unneutered male dog or cat or unsprayed female dog or cat, or one-half of these amounts if the dog or cat became 5 months of age after July 1 of any license year. Each owner applying for a neutered or spayed dog or cat license shall, at the time of the application, present to the City Treasurer a certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian that said dog or cat has been neutered or spayed by the veterinarian.

The license year commences on January 1 and ends on the following December 31.

The City Treasurer shall assess and collect a late fee of \$5.00 from every owner of a dog or cat 5 months of age or over, if the owner fails to obtain a license prior to April 1 of each year, or within 30 days of acquiring ownership of a licensable dog or cat, or if the owner failed to obtain a license on or before the dog or cat reached the licensable age. All late fees received or collected shall be paid into the general fund. For more information contact the City Treasurer's Office at 920-686-6965.
