1. Meeting Called to Order at 4:02 by D. Weber
2. Motion to approve 5/25/10 Minutes made by A. Schuette. Seconded by R. Wolfe. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Communications:
 - A. **Brooke Schreiner, Invincible Office Furniture – pedestrian crossing S 26th Street**
The request was for a crosswalk from the employee parking lot to the building.
This issue was tabled until someone from Invincible could be present.
 - B. **Ald. Jim Brey – referral from 7-8-10 Public Property & Safety meeting**
Discussed the request for right of way signage at Maritime Dr and N 10th St.
Motion made by R. Wolfe to leave it as is. Seconded by S. McMeans. Carried unanimously
Discussed the request for No Parking on east side of N 21st St adjacent to Citizens Park
Motion made by A. Schuette to leave it as is. Seconded by R. Kramer. Carried unanimously
Discussed the request for a right turn only lane on Maritime Drive heading west at N 8th St intersection Motion made by S. McMeans to make a right turn only lane for westbound traffic on Maritime Dr at the N 8th St intersection. Seconded by L. Denamur. Carried unanimously.
Discussed request for Stop signs being placed on Wisconsin St corridor
Motion made by A. Schuette to leave it as is. Seconded by L. Denamur. Carried Unanimously
 - C. **Norma Bishop, WI Maritime Museum – pedestrian crossing on Maritime Drive**
Discussed the safety of pedestrians trying to cross Maritime Dr at N 6th and N 7th St.
Motion made by S. McMeans to paint a crosswalk on Maritime Drive at N 7th St.
Seconded by P. Kohlmeier. Carried unanimously.
 - D. **S. Kleinfeldt, Principal Jackson Elem – 2 hr parking on N 18th St**
Discussed the request for 2 hr parking on West side of N 18th S from Menasha Ave to Belmont St from 7am to 3pm on days school is in session to allow for more movement of traffic.
Motion made by L. Denamur to support the 2 hr Parking as presented. Seconded by A. Schuette. Carried unanimously.

 - A. **No bikes on sidewalks** – R. Kramer discussed problem of people riding bikes on sidewalks.
