

PUBLIC UTILITIES AND LICENSING  
MINUTES OF THE JANUARY 31, 2012 MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 4:30 p.m. by Chairperson Hennessey. The following members were present: Sladky, Hennessey, and Soeldner. Also present: Mayor Nickels, City Clerk Hudon, Jim Muenzenmeyer, Alder Braunel, Val Mellon and Asst. Attorney McDaniels.

The Friends of Citizens Park Rec Center had requested the City to obtain a raffle license for their upcoming event. Asst. Atty. McDaniel researched the issue and found that the City could not apply for the license on behalf of another entity.

Jim Muenzenmeyer discussed the service changes in the bus routes and indicated that they have not yet been approved. He indicated paratransit hours must be equal to the bus routes and paratransit needs to run in the morning for dialysis patients. A hearing will be held at the Senior Center and will be forwarded to Common Council after the hearing. Alderperson Soeldner made a motion to approve the changes in service and public hearing. Second by Alderperson Sladky and carried unanimously.

Jim Muenzenmeyer discussed a temporary transfer station for the time period when the new terminal is being constructed. He suggested the old Ace Driving School property. Alderperson Soeldner asked if it met ADA requirements. Jim advised it is accessible except for the bathroom. Washington Park was briefly discussed as an option. Alderperson Sladky made a motion to authorize Jim to negotiate a rental arrangement. Alderperson Soeldner seconded and the motion was adopted unanimously.

Alderperson made a motion to adjourn. Alderperson Soeldner seconded and the meeting adjourned at 5:05.
