PUBLIC UTILITIES & LICENSING COMMITTEE MINUTES OF THE SEPTEMBER 20, 2012 MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Hennessey at 5:00 p.m. The following members were present: Alderpersons Hennessey, Able, Soeldner, Braunel and Sladky.

Alderperson Soeldner addressed the Committee relative to a consent agenda for the Common Council. In an effort to make the meetings run more smoothly, Alderperson Soeldner is suggesting we look into what types of items can be placed on a consent agenda. Or, perhaps committees can just bundle several noncontroversial documents for action at one time. Further discussion may be held after consulting with the City Attorney, Mayor and Clerk.
