Committee of the Whole met at City Hall on Monday, February 3, 2014, at 6:15 p.m. at City Hall in the First Floor Conference Room – West.

Council President Jill Hennessey called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

Mayor Nickels outlined the terms of the proposed agreement with Mainly Manitowoc.

It was thought that the money saved over the years by the Farmers' Market in the amount of approximately \$34,000 was to be used to maintain the property. However, City Planner David Less stated that when the market moved downtown from the former Lakeview Center property, it was the intent that the funds be the start-up money for whoever would take over the market.

Per Jamie Zastrow, Executive Director, Mainly Manitowoc, the Farmers' Market packets are ready to go out with no changes. It was noted that these packets need to go out very soon.

A lengthy discussion followed. No action was taken.
