

COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC UTILITIES AND LICENSING

MONDAY, January 18, 2010

Committee on Public Utilities and Licensing met at City Hall on Monday, January 18, 2010, at 5:15 p.m. in the First Floor Hearing Room - East.

Aldersperson Dean Graunke called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

Present: Alderspersons Dean Graunke, Dave Soeldner, Jason Sladky and Christopher Able.

Absent: Aldersperson Scott McMeans.

Also present: City Clerk Jennifer Hudon, Dir. of Public Works/City Engineer Valerie Mellon, Transit Manager Derek Muench, Jeff Agee-Aguayo and So. 10th Street residents.

Committee met to discuss communication (09-733) from residents of N. 10th Street objecting to Maritime Metro Transit Route #2 utilizing wholly residential street. Residents concerns were discussed. Transit Manager Derek Muench asked for 60-90 days to review the route. Committee referred the matter to Safety, Traffic and Parking Commission for their input and report back to this committee.

Transit Manager Derek Muench addressed the committee regarding agreement (10-007) for 2010 specialized transportation master agreement extension with Assist-to-Transport, LLC to extend original agreement dated January 2, 2007 for the year 2010. Department of Transportation is asking for a one-year contract instead of a two-year contract.

Moved by Able, seconded by Soeldner, and unanimously carried to approve the one-year agreement. Ayes, 4. Nays, none.

Committee then discussed yearly request from Manitowoc County Fair purveyors to extend the noise ordinance and hours for the sale of alcohol beverages during fair week. After a short discussion, the committee recommended that a letter be sent to the beer sale purveyors reminding them of the alcohol regulations, especially serving beer to intoxicated patrons.

Moved and seconded, meeting adjourned at 6:00 p.m.
