**Houck Advertizing** -Jim reported that we no longer are doing the advertizing agreement with WOMT. Jim budgeted for the year of 2016 a total of \$4,000 of revenue for advising. As of right now we receive more like \$2,000 a month for the advertizing on the buses and we are get more new ads everyday. We still offer one bus to WOMT for radio advertizing.

**County Fair**-passenger, riders and Jerry Neuser all had nothing but good things to say about Maritime Metro Transit going to the fair this year. We will do it again next year. We only went into the fair on the half hour run.

**Holiday Parade**- Maritime Metro Transit is going to be in the holiday parade this year with a special guest.

**TDP**-in September Bay Lake Regional Planning hired 15 people to do surveys on the buses we received 622 surveys back we don't have the information from those surveys at this time. A week later Bay Lakes did a boarding and lighting survey to help us look at how much each of the stops and shelters are used. These surveys help us make improvements in the future.

**Procurement of the buses**- The state is working on specs for buses so it will be easier in future when purchasing new buses. It will be at least one year before we will receive the new buses

**Mobility Manager Position**- was under the roof of Maritime Metro transit and was moved under the county roof in recent years. and now we would like that position moved back to Maritime Metro Transit. Tom Keil made a motion for Jim Muenzenmeyer to take this proposal to the City Council, Janet Paszkiewitz seconded it and all approved.

**Other Business**-Jim stated a rider lost his privileges to ride the bus for six months. He received a letter stating that.
