

COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC UTILITIES AND LICENSING

MINUTES OF TUESDAY, JUNE 22, 2010

Committee met in the First Floor Conference Room-West of City Hall and Chairperson Jill Hennessey called the meeting to order at 5:00 P.M.

Present: Alderpersons Jill Hennessey, James N. Brey, Nicholas Levendusky, Dave Soeldner and Jason Sladky.

Absent: None.

Also present: City Clerk Jennifer Hudon, Deputy Police Chief Bridget Brennan, Asst. City Attorney Kathleen McDaniel and Cesar Alvarez, applicant.

Chairperson Hennessey explained that the committee is meeting for the purpose of a scheduled non-renewal hearing for bartender license. (A complete tape recording of the hearing is on file in the City Clerk's office and a transcript can be prepared, upon request of either party, at their own expense.)

The non-renewal hearing for the 2010 - 2012 Two Year Operator's license of Cesar Alvarez was scheduled for 5:00 P.M.

Assistant City Attorney Kathleen McDaniel advised that the hearing will be held in accordance with Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes and explained the hearing procedure.

Deputy Police Chief Bridget Brennan was sworn by City Clerk Hudon.

Deputy Chief Brennan reviewed the applicant's police records, answered questions, and recommended denial of the license.

Cesar Alvarez was sworn by City Clerk Hudon.

Cesar Alvarez provided testimony and answered questions.

Chairperson Hennessey announced that notice is hereby given that the governmental body will adjourn to a closed session during the meeting as authorized by Section 19.85(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes, which authorizes the governmental body to convene in closed session for the purpose of deliberating concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before that governing body.

Committee deliberated on the evidence introduced at the non-renewal hearing of Cesar Alvarez.

Moved by Alderperson Brey, seconded by Alderperson Soeldner to recommend denial of the 2010 - 2012 Two Year Operator's license of Cesar Alvarez. Ayes, 5. Nays, none.
