4) Request for public input: No public input.

5) Membership Matters: As of now we are full. Nancy Boeck will be taking a leave of absence from president and the committee. We may have membership openings beginning January.

6) TRIAD Update: On October 24 they had a meeting at Felician Hall and it was there largest turnout. Lt Rick Tissler from the Sheriff's Office is now on the committee.
