5) Membership Matters: Sadly, Wendy Smith passed away. She was a board member and a member of the financial committee. 6) TRIAD Update: They met on November 21. Next week they will be touring the jail and dispatch center. They are still working on getting more deactivation packs, which dissolve medication. Lt. Rick Tissler, from the Manitowoc County Sheriff's Office is a new member.

7) High School Members Update: Memphys reported that Lincoln High School is still having issues with vaping, dab pens and fighting. The van has started to pick up truant students again. Ryllie from Manitowoc Lutheran stated that they are studying for exams and the Christmas concert is December 20. There were no major problems to report.

8) MTSO Update: Deputy Schwede In January the jail will be starting 12 hour shifts. The Metro Drug Unit has been busy with Meth related cases. Their long term evidence room is moving to make more space. They have had two semi accidents and four fatal accidents. Their Policy and Procedure Manual is going digital. They have organized a uniform committee that is considering black polo tops and tundra green pants.

9) SRO Update: December is lock down month. Students will be practicing lock downs. Each school will be having a safety meeting each month and a monthly meeting with the school district to improve safety. Fire drills are now announced to reduce the fear of school shootings. More cameras have been placed in common areas. The middle school DARE graduations had 188 students from the south side and 160 from the north side. In February or March, the 7th grade DARE classes will begin. The P3 system will be starting. It is similar to crime stoppers, only the phone calls will go to a dispatcher in Texas, which in turn gets sent back to us.

12) City Council Update: The Public Safety Committee is working on regulating message therapy ordinances and licenses to help reduce questionable activity. Stop signs were placed on the intersection of South 22nd Street and Division Street. A budget passed for a Law 10) Citizens Academy Update: The group meets every 2nd Wednesday. They are preparing for the next course. If we know of anybody who wants to apply, it runs from the end of February to the end of April from 6pm to 9pm.
