He continued that additional data is required to both validate parking structure or surface parking options and to obtain professional design options if the need is identified. N. Sparacio provided the example of Forefront Dermatology possibly exceeding their parking needs after 2017. D. Koski confirmed the deteriorated condition of the existing entertainment stage at Red Arrow Park.
