

## COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC UTILITIES AND LICENSING

### MINUTES OF TUESDAY, JUNE 30, 2010

Committee met in the First Floor Hearing Room-East of City Hall and Chairperson Jill Hennessey called the meeting to order at 5:00 P.M.

Present: Alderpersons Jill Hennessey, James N. Brey, and Jason Sladky. Alderperson Dave Soeldner arrived at 5:05 p.m.

Absent: Nicholas Levendusky.

Also present: Police Chief Tony Dick, Dir. of Public Works/Engineer Valerie Mellon, Transit Manager Derek Muench, Jeffrey C. Agee-Aguayo of Bay-Lake Regional Planning Commission and Deputy City Clerk Deborah Neuser. In addition representatives from local grocery stores and liquor stores were present along with former Alderperson Ray Geigel.

Chairperson Hennessey called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

Jeffrey C. Agee-Aguayo of Bay-Lake Regional Planning Commission gave a summary of the Transit Development Program (TDP) for the Maritime Metro Transit System prepared by Bay-Lake Regional Planning Commission for the period from 2010 through 2014 which includes the cities of Manitowoc and Two Rivers. His summary included community research, goals, objectives and standards, alternatives/route revision analysis and a recommended plan.

Transit Manager Derek Muench addressed the committee and answered questions.

Moved by Alderperson Sladky, seconded by Alderperson Soeldner and unanimously carried to adopt the Maritime Metro Transit Development Program (TDP) for 2010 - 2012. Ayes, 4. Nays, none.

The next items of business were ordinance (10-323) to amend Section 11.01(10)(d) regarding intoxicating liquor sales to include frozen pizzas and ordinance (10-202) to amend Section 11.01(10) regarding the license area for the sale of "Class A" Intoxicating Liquor.

Chairperson Hennessey took comments from Ray Geigel, and various representatives of local grocery stores and liquor stores and then opened the meeting for committee discussion.

Moved by Alderperson Brey, seconded by Alderperson Sladky and unanimously carried

recommending not to adopt ordinance (10-202) regarding a change to the license area for the sale of “Class A” Intoxicating Liquor. Ayes, 4. Nays, none.

Moved by Alderperson Sladky, seconded by Alderperson Brey to adopt ordinance (10-323) regarding intoxicating liquor sales to include frozen pizzas. After a short discussion, Ayes, 2. Nays, 2. Motion failed.

Moved by Alderperson Sladky, seconded by Alderperson Soeldner and unanimously carried, the Committee adjourned at 6:10 P.M.
