6) TRIAD Update: They are still distributing lock boxes. They plan on scheduling jail and morgue tours.

10) SRO Update: In December they will be working on lockdown drills. DARE is complete for the year. Lincoln High School released a video about cyber bullying to parents, educating them on anonymous accounts. Wilson counselors are developing a program to educate students on cyber bullying.

11) Citizens Academy Update: They have received 9 applications since Monday and are accepting applications until January 11. They are having officers apply to assist with the 10 week program. They are in the process of scheduling what the officers will do.

12) Healthiest Manitowoc County Substance Abuse Prevention: They are working with Sgt. Krock on lockboxes and Delta 88.

13) City Council Update: The mayor approved the additional detective, who will be focused on child crimes and human trafficking.

14) CPC Activities/Project/Scams: Amazon scams involve email or a call claiming their Amazon account is being used. This is a fraudulent way in attempt to get bank or login information on people's Amazon accounts.
