**5) Membership Matters:** New member, Haelee Bauer is the Mayor's Assistant. Waiting on common council to appoint her to CPC.

**6) TRIAD Update:** Sgt. Krock reported that TRIAD Members participated in a Fire Department tour. No November meeting and December meeting was bumped up one week due to the Holidays. Next tour will be in the Spring.

**8) MTPD Update:** Sgt. Krock reported two recent Lieutenant promotions, Kim Albright and Bruce Tuma. Northside DARE had its graduation, 155 students. Immanuel's DARE graduation will be held on December 12<sup>th</sup>. The Police Department is currently hiring for three current and/or future openings. Mali was recently diagnosed with Lyme's disease but is asymptomatic and is doing well. The Holiday Faire Extraordinaire raised \$9,400 for Police Lights of Christmas Program.

**10) SRO Update:** SRO Rocklewitz reported that vaping along with THC vapes continue to be a big issue in the schools. On Tuesday, they conducted K9 sniffs. Wilson had no issues. **11) Citizens' Academy:** Sgt. Krock reported that they are now accepting applications for the 2023 Citizens' Academy and have received 19 applications. Krock reported a recent scam regarding a text message that is being sent to victims stating that their package delivery is being suspended because the package delivery address is missing street information. The text message also contains a link for the victim to click on. The link will ask you to confirm your address and will request credit card information to ensure the package is delivered. This is a phishing scam that has been prevalent around the Holidays as many people are receiving packages this time of year.
