1. The meeting was called to Order by Chairman N. Levendusky at 5:00pm.
2. Approval of the Parks and Recreation Committee Minutes from the September 7, 2010 meeting.
 - a. Motion by D. Soeldner to approve the minutes
 - b. Second by J. Sladky
 - c. Motion passed 4-0
3. A motion was made by D. Soeldner, seconded by J. Sladky to approve all requests. Motion passed 4-0.
 - a. Request PR2010-058, Friends of the Mariner's Trail-Trail a Thon, to use Mariner's Trail on July 16, 2011.
 - b. Request PR2010-059, Manitowoc Garden Fair, Marion Parworth to use Washington Park on June 11, 2011.
 - c. Request PR2010-060, Cerebral Palsy Inc, donation item for the 2010 CP Auction. J. Sladky made a motion to give a Family Pass for the Aquatic Center, seconded by D. Soeldner. Motion passed 4-0.
 - d. Request PR2010-061, Lincoln Football Booster Club, to use picnic tables and large grill at Municipal Football field October 9, 2010. Approved by Common Council September 20, 2010
4. New Business
 - a. Union Park tennis courts removal-N. Levendusky discussed that DPW could remove and replace the grass. V. Melon discussed the removal of 8 inches over the whole area. Labor and trucks for 4 days \$23,000, 650 cubic yards, 2 days labor and equipment \$16,000 for fence removal. Total \$40,000 rounded numbers. Earliest the project could be done in March or April. The committee would like the department to explore the ordinance issue to see if DPW can do the work. George Kapitz is a part of a bike polo group. They would be interested in helping raise funds to have a bike polo court. Right now they are using Union Park.

- b. Zoological Board and Zoological Society letter for hiring support. Placed on file.
- c. 2 man golf league letter for shelter at Lincoln Park. Placed on file.
- d. Municipal Field restroom/concession request from Kevin Stangel. Placed on file.
- e. Silverridge park concept plan. Dan Wergin discussed the fact that the city was supposed to give a plan for the park within two years. It has been four years already. He has seen only one plan. D. Soeldner held up the plan and thought design was for a neighborhood park. J. Sladky would like to have a green space. D. Soeldner would like to move forward and approve a concept plan. Dan Wergin would like to see us add a concept plan, as lots get sold. They may even donate some playground equipment. J. Sladky made a motion for the department to work with the developers to come up with a plan and bring back to the committee. Seconded by D. Soeldner. Motion carried 4-0.

- a. An informational drawing was handed out to the committee regarding the Organization of the Parks and Recreation Department.
- b. A motion was made by D. Soeldner to place Little Manitowoc River study proposal on file, seconded by J. Sladky. Motion carried 4-0.
- c. Erosion issues at Silver Creek Park, Val Mellon handed out an estimate for Silver Creek Park to the committee.
- d. Park priorities for 2011 update and 5 year plan, the committee would like to see the list of priorities for the parks initiative and a special meeting will be called at the next council meeting October 18, 2010 at 5pm.
