1. The meeting was called to Order by Chairman N. Levendusky at 5:00pm.
2. Delay approval of the Parks and Recreation Committee Minutes from the July 7, 2010 meeting until second page is sent to committee.
3. Requests
  - a. Request PR2010-043, Lakeshore Kids Weekend, Randy Heinzen, to use Wenger Band Shell, picnic tables, benches, and ticket booth at YMCA/Manitowoc Marina Area on August 6-8, 2010. Waiver of fees requested. A motion was made by J. Sladky, seconded by D. Soeldner to approve the request and charge \$150.00 rental fee. The motion carried all in favor.
  - b. Request PR2010-044, United Way Kickoff, waiver of fees requested. A motion was made by J. Sladky, seconded by C. Able to approve the request and charge \$150.00 rental fee. The motion carried all in favor.
  - c. Request PR2010-045, YMCA Flag football, Jane Gates to use Lakeview Park Field on Sept 7-Oct 21, 2010. Waiver of fees requested. A motion was made by J. Sladky, seconded by M. Kadow to approve the request. The motion carried all in favor.
  - d. Request PR2010-046, Special Olympics, Richard Rosinsky to use Citizen Park Gym for volleyball. Waiver of fees requested. A motion was made by C. Able, seconded by M. Kadow to approve the request. The motion carried all in favor.
4. New Business
  - a. Ice Age Trial signage, report from Cheryl Gorsuch. A motion was made by J. Sladky, seconded by C. Able to refer this to the Street, Traffic & Parking Committee. The motion carried all in favor.

- b. Bandits proposal for improvement fund payments, report from James Maurer. The Bandits didn't expect to pay for the lattice. Would like \$9000 paid so they can continue to move forward with the payment with their yearly payments of \$3000 and work on principal instead of just the interest.
  - c. Waiver of fees requests for the Family Aquatic Center. Approval granted for the requests from this year.
  - d. Zoological member appreciation day is August 14, 2010
  - e. Motion from Recreation Board regarding hours of operation for 2011 at the Manitowoc Family Aquatic Center. .
  - f. The county bridge on highway LS adjacent to Silver Creek Park is a trip hazard. Engineering department gave an estimate to fix it for approximately \$1,900.00. The county is not interested in fixing the bridge and will close it. This leaves the golfers going out in the street or crossing the creek another way. Jim VanLanden will look into maintenance.
  - g. Jim VanLanden requests that the disc golf fairways at Indian Creek Park be more defined and the long grass be cut down. Jim will help the parks department to get this accomplished. A motion was by C. Able, seconded by M. Kadow to grant the request.
  - h. Dale Street Park-tennis courts status and usage. A motion was made by M. Kadow to not allow usage of the parks tennis courts, no second motion. Motion died.
  - i. Problems with locked restrooms and usage needs.
