2) Minutes: Approved. 1st by Deputy Zach Smith. 2nd by Nicole Palama.

3) Treasurer Report: Approved. 1st by Jackie LaBre. 2nd by Deputy Zach Smith.

4) Public Input: No public input. Two members from the public present.

5) Membership Matters: Currently 2-3 open positions on CPC. Meetings are first Thursday of every month – no meetings in July/August.

6) TRIAD Update: Hosting a table with info about scams and TRIAD at the Senior Center Health Fair on May 8th from 8am-12pm. Members may attend AARP Scam Jam in Milwaukee on April 20th. Members taking a tour of the Wastewater Treatment Facility in May.

7) High School Members: No members present. Logan Brooks (Lutheran) provided email update – not many behavioral issues. Student incentive day was held last week. Prom is scheduled for April 27th at The Venue. Three local high schools are hosting a foster care supply drive with the winner receiving a plaque.

8) MTPD Update: Sgt. Krock reported that the City bicycle auction is April 27th at the Parks Department. Clerical Staff has been hosting lunch fundraisers at the PD and have raised about \$400 so far this year for the Lakeshore Humane Society. PD is researching mass communication systems to notify Officers and have them report for duty that can be used in the event of a large-scale incident. Eagles Club Officer of the Year received five officer nominations – winner has yet to be announced. Tours of PD/Presentations have been in high demand.

9) MTSO Update: Deputy Smith reported that Eagles Club Officer of the Year was awarded to Deputy Gamez and Correctional Officer Sgt. Smith. Deputy Landon Koenig is stepping up as dive team leader. Seven retirements are being anticipated within the next year in addition to regular turnover/lateral transfers. CAD is being installed in squads in June.

10) SRO Update: Sgt. Krock reported that D.A.R.E. Graduation for the southside elementary schools will be held the first week in May. Roncalli D.A.R.E. Graduation is being held April 30th.

11) Citizens' Academy/Alumni: Nicole Palama and Sgt. Krock reported that the Academy has been going well and is over halfway completed with Graduation scheduled for April 30th at Seven Lakes.

12) Healthiest Manitowoc County Substance Use Prevention Coalition: April that a recent Narcan Vending Machine meeting was successful. NEWAHEC is in the process of exploring insurance options for the machine. Manitowoc County schools were provided with Emergency Overdose Kits that contain Narcan, wipes, and CPR masks/gloves to be placed in existing AED cases. 13) InCourage Update: Violet reported that April is sexual assault awareness month; each Wednesday they are putting out a new infographic on social media to raise awareness.
