7) High School Members: Lizzie Boss (Lincoln) reported that this weekend the theater program was performing a play. The LHS Prom is being held at the Venue on May 18th. May 17th the Lincoln Chamber Choir will be performing at MPSD elementary schools. May 31st a Spotlight Concert Choir will be held. Logan Brooks (Lutheran) provided email update – Prom was recently held at the Venue where the DJ complimented the students on their good behavior. May 1st featured an Arbor Day celebration where sophomores and seniors cleaned up Lincoln Park, freshman cleaned up school grounds, and juniors helped teachers with their own yard work. Graduation is scheduled for Saturday, May 25th.

8) MTPD Update: Sgt. Krock reported that the City bicycle auction on April 27th raised over \$3000 and featured over 175 items. Ali Hanson was awarded the Eagles Club Officer of the Year for her volunteer work throughout the community. Tours of PD/Presentations have been in high demand. Former MTPD Officer Amber Thiel was hired back at the PD. Two recruit officers will be graduating in May and will then begin the field training process. MTPD was represented at a recent career fair at Fox Valley Technical College. Recently several building security assessments were conducted at several MPSD schools as well as Felician Village.
