## **Approval of the Minutes from the February 21st, 2024 Meeting**

Motion made by F. Radandt and seconded by L. Kummer to approve the meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously, no further discussion.

## **New Business**

### **Boating Infrastructure Grant – BIG Grant Award City of Manitowoc**

P. Braun explained that the City of Manitowoc worked with Marina staff and MSA consultants to author the BIG grant application. The application was for a tier 2 BIG grant which is up to \$1,500,000 and are competitively ranked at the national level. The City was the only Midwestern community to receive tier 2 funding. The award was in the amount of \$439,000 and will be used for the replacement of “A” dock.

### **Manitowoc Marina “A” Dock Replacement**

R. Larson provided an update to the “A” Dock replacement. “A” dock is the most expensive of all the docks because it has the refueling and dump station infrastructure located on it. Lunda Construction was the low bidder. They are planning to begin the demo of the dock in November and are planning to have the new dock in place by April 2025 before the sailing season.

### **Army Corps of Engineers Confined Disposal Facility (CDF) and Breakwater Planned Work for 2025 & 2026.**

P. Braun stated that the Army Corps of Engineers will begin Breakwater repair work on the South and North breakwater in 2025 with the repairs expected to be completed in 2026. Work on the south breakwater will begin at a point just east of the revetment stone adjacent to the wastewater treatment plant and will run to the point where the sheet wall begins by the south breakwater signal light. Work on the north breakwater will begin east of the CDF out to the lighthouse. The work will include drilling of holes

on the top surface of the concrete and pumping concrete grout into the breakwater substructure.
