150th Anniversary Logo Design Contest Rules

INTRODUCTION:

This document describes the official rules of the City of Manitowoc's 150th Anniversary Logo Design Contest. The object of this contest is to design a logo for the City of Manitowoc's 150th Anniversary that will be celebrated in 2020. The winning logo will be used as the official 150th Anniversary logo on promotional materials, the City of Manitowoc website, social media, and in many other ways. Your design will be a very important part of our continued history, and should reflect our past, present, and future.

ELIGIBILITY:

- 1) Entrant must be a City of Manitowoc resident or full-time student in the City of Manitowoc
- 2) Entrants of all ages are encouraged to enter
- 3) Entrants may submit up to two entries for the Contest
- 4) Entrants under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the Official Entry Form
- 5) There is no fee to enter the contest

HOW TO ENTER:

- 1) Download and complete the Official Entry Form. The form is available for download at www.manitowoc.org.
- 2) Create a logo!
- 3) Convert the design in a manner that allows for use in full color, one color, and/or black and white.
- 4) Email your completed Official Entry Form, a signed copy of the Contest Rules, and your design to Manitowoc150@manitowoc.org.
- 5) The Committee will attempt to acknowledge all Entries by email, however, we cannot be held responsible for Entries lost in the submission process. If you want to ensure your entry is received and you did not receive a follow up email, please call the Mayor's Office at (920) 686-6980.

FORMATTING AND SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:

- 1) The logo will need to look good in black and white as well as in color.
- 2) The logo needs to look good at relatively small sizes as well as larger sizes.
- 3) Entrants should take care to ensure that their Entries are not in any way similar to existing logos or other copyrighted images.
- 4) Please submit the design in .png, .jpg, or .psd (Resolution of 300 dpi) AND as a .pdf file (less than 10MB). If the logo incorporates non-standard fonts, you must be able to provide us with the font should your logo be selected. If you are chosen as the winner, you MUST be able to provide a high-resolution vector file.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES:

You must submit your design and completed entry form by 11:59 p.m. CST on 6/12/2019.

LOOK AND FEEL GUIDELINES:

The winning logo will include iconic features of the City of Manitowoc; should represent the past, present, and future of the City of Manitowoc; should include the words City of Manitowoc; and should include either the date of 03/12/1870 or 1870-2020.

PRIZES:

The artist whose logo is ultimately selected will receive a certificate of appreciation, recognition by Mayor Justin Nickels, and a prize basket valued at a minimum of \$300.00.

JUDGING AND SELECTION OF THE WINNER:

- 1) The winning design will be selected by a committee appointed by the Mayor. Their decision will be final and is not appealable.
- 2) Accepting recognition of the winning design constitutes permission for the City of Manitowoc to make public and otherwise use the name of the winner for publicity purposes.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY:

- 1) All submitted work must be original and not based on any pre-existing design.
- 2) All entries will become the sole property of the City of Manitowoc and may be displayed publicly.
- 3) The Entrant agrees to transfer all rights and title to the Entry to the City of Manitowoc in accordance with the Official Rules of this Contest.
- 4) In the event that the winning Entry may be found to infringe on existing logos or other copyrighted images, the Entrant may be held responsible for expenses incurred by the City of Manitowoc from the use of the Entry.

ACCEPTANCE:

Participation in this Contest constitutes the Entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules. By participating in the Contest, the Entrant is representing and warranting that he/she has read and understood, and agrees to be bound by, these rules. These Official Rules constitute the entire agreement between the Entrant and the City of Manitowoc in relation to the Contest. The Official Rules govern the Entrant’s participation and supersede any prior or other agreements between the Entrant and the City of Manitowoc relating to this Contest.
