ABOUT THE PROJECT

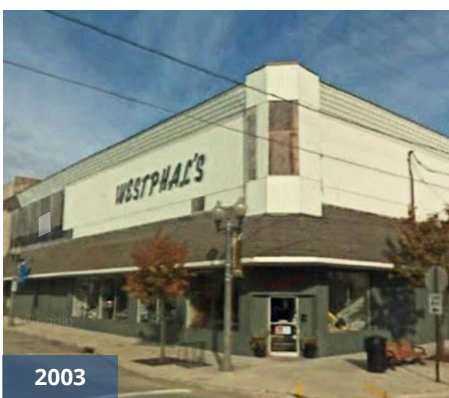
Originally built in the late 1800s, support for this project helped to protect and restore a true Downtown Manitowoc icon. The building has been utilized for numerous businesses throughout its history including as a bike shop and Westphal's Hardware Store. Today it has been restored to bring new life to the downtown 8th Street corridor as the Pizza Garden, a family-friendly restaurant and entertainment business.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- \$50,000 Façade Grant Award
- \$150,000 estimated restoration project
- Removed corrugated metal siding and restored original stamped metal building
- Replaced all windows and reinstated missing lower storefront and trim
- Reinstated lost turret
