REGISTRATION

All registration must be processed on or before the registration deadline, through the Recreation Office or Online. Classes and activities are filled on a first-come basis. If a program is full, you will be placed on a waiting list and notified if and when a spot to register opens up

Full payment is due at the time of registration.

Cancellation/Refund Policy:

- If MPRD cancels a program, a full refund will be given.
- If a participant cancels at least two weeks prior to the program start date, full refund (less a \$10 cancellation fee) will be given.
- Cancellations less than two weeks prior to the program start date will not be refunded.
- Transfer of programs, dates, etc will result in \$5 fee.

Refunds can be issued in the following forms:

- Credit to your account to use toward future registrations.
- Credit to your credit card used to pay the registration fee.
- Check will be issued. This can take up to 14 business days to process.

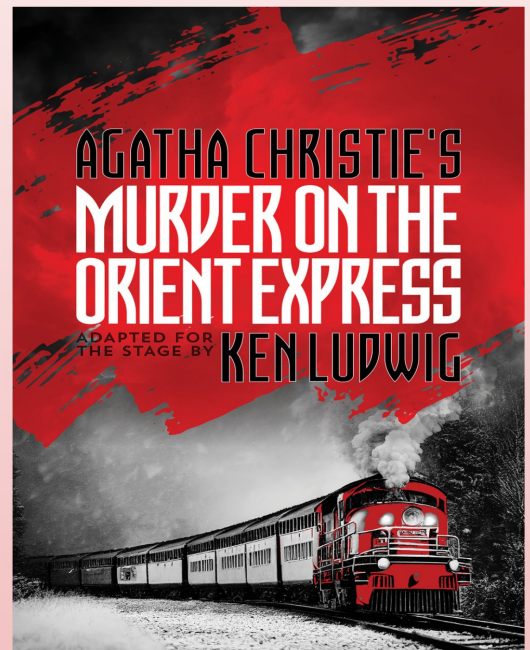
Murder on the Orient Express
