2021 Deer Harvest Regulations

Deer may be harvested within the City of Manitowoc on private property or designated city owned property (hereafter referred to as “authorized property”) in accordance with exceptions to Municipal Ordinance 14.24(2) as directed by Resolution of Manitowoc City Council.

The harvest will be conducted under the following conditions:

1. Through the use of bow and arrow or crossbow;
2. Upon the undeveloped portions of authorized property(ies);
3. From an elevated stand which is situated so as to direct discharged arrows away from populated areas;
4. With the expressed permission of the property owner.
5. Anyone hunting within an authorized area will register with the property owner by providing his/her name, address, telephone number, vehicle year, make, and registration number.
6. The hunters will keep a record of the number of deer harvested from each of their properties. These lists will be collected by the Manitowoc Police Department following the close of the bow and arrow hunting season. The information will be used to assess the effectiveness of the harvest.
7. Legally tagged deer will be field dressed by hunters **only** upon the authorized property or, upon property lying outside the City, with the permission of the landowner.
8. Hunters will make every attempt to cause the harvested animals to remain upon the authorized property. Should a deer that has been struck by an arrow travel off the authorized property into a residential area, the Manitowoc Police Department will be contacted immediately.
9. Hunting privileges upon the authorized properties or the hunt itself may be terminated by the Chief of Police if circumstances deem this to be necessary.
10. All tree stands left in the publicly owned lands, shall have the owners name clearly marked on the stand. The owner’s contact information shall be supplied to the Police Dept. and the owner shall notify the Police Dept. of any contact information changes during the hunting season, if the stand is on public land. Stands utilized on City property should not be placed before September 1st, and must be removed within 14 days of the season closing. (Permit information changes can be updated by calling Amber at 686-6559)
11. There is a current County Ordinance against baiting in Manitowoc County.
