ABOUT THE PROJECT

Originally built in the early 1900s as the Junk Fur and Hide Company, support for this project provided restoration and protection of the original building elements. Petskull Brewery serves as an eastern bookend of the River Point District. Previous reincarnations of the building included the Manitowoc Iron & Metal Co. The historic location is now home to a brewery, taproom with outdoor patio area, and a planned Cajun-themed restaurant.
