Requirement of Director of Building Inspection as required by Section 14.770 of the Municipal Code.

1. Certificates of Inspection for portable bleachers and any rides or mechanical devices.
2. Certificates of fireproofing of any canvas tents.
3. Proof of sanitary facilities

Insurance: Public liability insurance policy of a minimum of \$500,000 must be provided by the applicant, filed with the City Clerk and bear approval of the City Attorney. City Attorney requires that policy be submitted at least twenty-four hours before approval will be given.
